The Civilian Complaint Review Board, sets forth below its regulatory agenda for the City's fiscal year of 2018.

CIVILIAN COMPLAINT REVIEW BOARD

1. **SUBJECT:** Monthly Board Meetings
 - a. **Reason:** The Civilian Complaint Review Board ("CCRB") proposes to amend Rule § 1-51(a) ("Meetings of the Board") such that the CCRB Full Board will only be required to meet ten (10) times per year. Rule § 1-51(a) currently requires the Full Board to meet every month.
 - b. **Anticipated Contents:** Amendment of CCRB Rule § 1-51(a) ("Meetings of the Board").
 - c. **Objectives:** The objective of the proposed rule change is to give CCRB's Full Board the discretion and flexibility to determine which months it needs to convene for public meetings since Board members meet frequently throughout the course of every month to manage cases and other work related to the Agency.
 - d. **Legal Basis:** CCRB's Charter does not require CCRB's Full Board to meet every month. Accordingly, CCRB is permitted to amend Rule § 1-51(a).
 - e. **Types of Individuals and entities likely to be Affected:** General public.
 - f. **Other Relevant Laws:** N/A.
 - g. **Approximate Schedule:** First Quarter of FY 2018.
