

On behalf of The New York State Professional Process Servers Association, we propose the DCWP adopt the following amendment to 2-2336(2) (1) :

On every occasion that a process server attempts or effects service of process, the process server must ensure that the mobile device makes an electronic record of the GPS location, time and date of the attempted or effected service immediately before or after attempting or effecting service. If no GPS signal is available at the time of attempted or effected service of process, the location, time and date will be determined by triangulated cell tower signals.

The process server is in compliance with this provision if its electronic record was made immediately before the time of attempted or effected service or within one hour after the time of attempted or effected service.
